

NAPA Costume Hire

Terms and Conditions of Hire

All persons/organisations hiring costumes or other items from NAPA are required to abide by the following terms and conditions. Please read carefully and sign below to signify agreement with the terms.

1. Hire charges are usually based on a week's hire period. Longer periods of hire are available, although additional payment will normally be required. (Price will be dependent on number of costumes and time-frame involved).
 2. An additional refundable security deposit (usually £10.00 per costume) must accompany all hire fees. This deposit will be returned to you on safe return of the costumes.
 3. The costume/items must be returned on the agreed date and in the same condition you received them or the refundable security deposit may be partly or fully forfeited. (The only exception is if NAPA has been contacted on or prior to the agreed return date & another date has been accepted).
 4. Payments can be made by cash or card.
 5. Hire and security deposit must be paid upon collection of the costume(s) and/or accessories.
 6. The hired costumes/accessories remain the property of NAPA at all times. However, once they leave NAPA's premises they are no longer insured by NAPA and any loss or damage incurred is the hirer's responsibility.
 7. Any loss, or non-return of hired costumes or accessories, must be paid for in full. Should the hirer fail to return the items or contact NAPA within fourteen days of the agreed return date, then these goods will be treated as stolen. Action will be taken to recover our losses, such as the replacement cost of unreturned items, through the most appropriate method.
 8. Any damage to costumes or accessories must be paid for. (Normal wear and tear is taken into account).
 9. The cost of hire is inclusive of cleaning and general maintenance of costumes. Should items become dirty or damaged, do not under any circumstances attempt to clean or repair them, as some items will require specialist care and attention.
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
